In the event of cancellation all entry fees will be refunded. The Stallion Stakes monies for each year will be split with 60% into the Futurity and 40% into the Derby. Of these monies, 45% will go into the Open Futurity, 15% into the Limited Open Futurity, 25% into the Non Pro Futurity, and 15% in the the Amateur Division. **NO REFUNDS -- NO EXCEPTIONS.** No dogs are allowed inside the Pennington County Event Center.
