

## SDRCHA STALLION SERVICE AUCTION (Donation Information Sheet)

The SDRCHA is offering a stallion service auction to raise money for the further development of our Futurity and Derby. As a Stallion Stakes Stallion Owner, we are asking for a breeding service to your stallion(s) to be donated for this auction. All money raised by this auction will be added to the non-stallion stakes classes of our show. The auction will allow for more advertising of your stallion(s), encourage more participation in the continued growth for the ancillary classes and will afford more people the opportunity to see the quality of horses we are producing. Information will be posted on our website regarding available stallions for this auction.

Stallion Stakes Stallion Owners can participate by donating one or more breeding services to the SDRCHA by filling out the attached nomination form. The auction will run from January 15 to March 15.

The donation is for the breeding service only. Chute fees, breeding fees, shipped semen fees, mare care, and other additional fees are Mare Owner's responsibility and are payable to the Stallion Owner or breeding Agent upon initial receipt of mare. The breeding will be sold at 50% of the advertised stud fee to the first person who pays the fee. This will not be a progressive bidding auction. As breeding services are sold, the Stallion Owners will be notified of the sale and the person who purchased the breeding. The SDRCHA strongly suggests that upon receipt of the mare for breeding, that the Stallion Owner or representative has the Mare Owner sign their individual breeding contract in addition to the SDRCHA breeding contract.

SDRCHA reserves the right to modify or amend the rules of this program as unusual circumstances may deem necessary. The Stallion Owner, by participating in this program, does understand, agree, and accept the SDRCHA officers, members and representatives are not liable for death, sickness, and/or accidental injury including consequential damages to the stallion and/or Stallion Owner during participation in this breeding program caused by either negligent or intentional acts of any party to this contract.

The following information will need to be submitted with the Stallion Donation Contract:

Photocopy of stallion's registration papers

Stallion Owners Breeding contract for successful bidder (Please review your breeding contract. Please remove any incentives that are listed in your standard contracts if you do not want them to be passed on as part of SDRCHA Breeding Auction. If these incentives are left in the contract, the Mare Owner has every right to expect that those incentives are also being offered as part of breeding fee they are paying. The SDRCHA is not responsible for any incentives that are outlined in the Stallion Owners Breeding Contract.)

Information on stallion and any additional charges (ie collection fees, mare care, shipping fees, etc.)

Anything else that would be helpful in answering questions of Mare Owner.

We appreciate your assistance in promoting the sport of reined cow horse.
